

VAD'IM AND LEAT A.**ADDRESS: SDEROT****Victim Story – April 2015**

Vad'im and his wife, Leat are a young couple who immigrated from Russia to Israel. They have 4 children and they have endured many struggles during their short married life together.

Vad'im and Leat not only have to worry about deadly rocket attacks which come from Gaza, but he has also had to stop work for weeks in order to care for the life-threatening illness of their small son Yarin who sadly suffers from liver cancer. The two eldest children in the family are deeply concerned about

their brother and are often depressed.

Vad'im has frequently been unable to work due to the need to take Yarin to the hospital for expensive cancer treatments to save his life. Meanwhile, he and Leat have often been unable to pay for expensive specialized food that's required to help keep dear Yarin alive. If that is not enough, financial assistance by the government for the child's chemotherapy treatments has not been available, with overwhelming costly treatments being paid by concerned family and friends who often themselves do not have the money. The family recently got bigger as a new baby was added to it. They called him Adiel Chaim. Unfortunately, the new baby also has medical problems and 2 surgeries were needed. He is currently in Ashkelon hospital and doctors say his condition is not very good.



Because of these problems Vad'im, Leat and their children were living together with Vadim's mother and brother until recently, since they were not able to rent their own apartment. Finally, they now moved to their own apartment and they're living independently. V'adim is currently not working and looking for a job. Hands of Mercy is assisting them and bringing them support.

Despite these incredible hardships, the heartwarming love evidenced by this small family is deeply moving, as we pray and challenge them to place their trust in 'The Merciful One' for His healing!

Yarin's immune system is very poor following all the Chemo and he is often sick. Please pray for the survival of the youngest children and resolution to the family's many problems!
